ONLINE EVENT - The Annual Tate Talk 'Cambridge College Gardens' with Tim Richardson

Saturday 6th March 2021 at 2pm

Based on his book '**Cambridge College Gardens**' (*published in 2018 and reviewed in the NGT spring magazine 2020*) Tim will take us on a journey to explore the most exquisite gardens in and around the university of Cambridge's colleges combining an appreciation of the history, horticulture and atmosphere that these hallowed gardens provide.

The gardens are as rich and varied as the colleges themselves, often set within stunning architecture, and include formal quadrangles, naturalistic planting, walled gardens, rooftop oases, productive plots and watermeadows as well as the private spaces enjoyed exclusively by the college masters, porters and fellows.



Tim is a critic, historian and journalist, specialising in international garden design and landscape architecture. He is the founder-director of the Chelsea Fringe Festival, an international festival of art and gardening.

He has published widely on garden history and contributes to the Daily Telegraph, House and Gardens, Gardens Illustrated and Country Life.

*His latest book (2020) '**Sissinghurst The Dream Garden**' gives the most up-to-date exploration of the garden at Sissinghurst, how it was created and why it remains such a great and much-loved garden.*
